

Supplementary Fig. S2 | Contralateral and ipsilateral motor activity in the -300-0ms interval relative to the target onset. The results of a paired t-test showed that there was no significant difference between contralateral and ipsilateral sides, t(19) = 0.847, p = 0.408. Moreover, a Bayesian t-test yielded a Bayes factor of BF₀₁ = 3.13, providing moderate evidence for the absence of a difference.
